What is the GK-Atelier?

- Architectural studio specializing for 10 years in the design of spaces and public facilities, including: public libraries, academic libraries, school libraries, community centers, museums, galleries, etc.
- I am a member of the Association of Polish Architects and the Association of Interior Designers.
- The only studio in Poland that created an internal library design system based on analysis of the needs of modern users and on information collected directly from librarians (we organized meetings with readers and librarians)
- The first studio in Poland to start coming up with names for designed libraries and their logos as part of interior design projects
- We cooperate with Polish and foreign library organizations, e.g. IFLA
